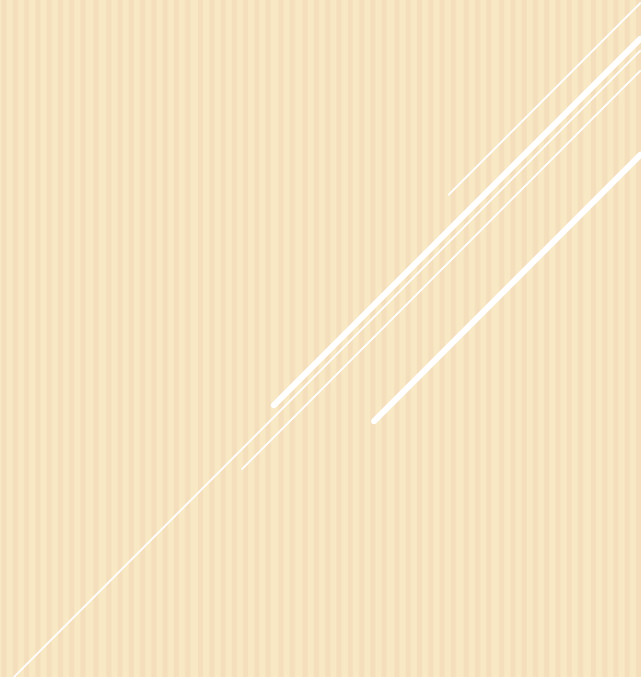

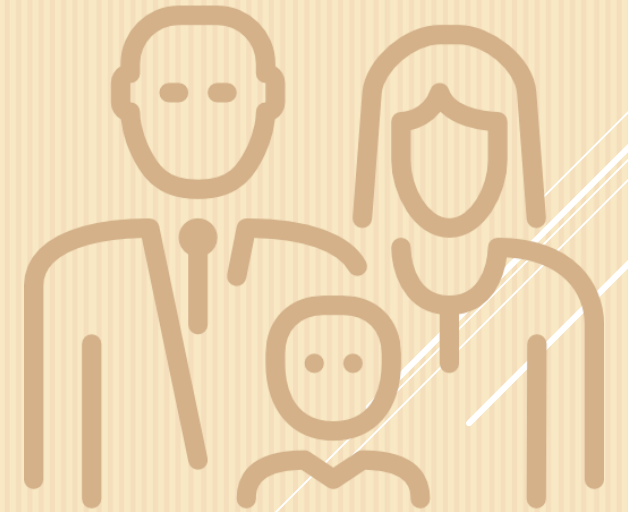
Before applying for citizenship, you need to have the **desire** to become a citizen of the new country.

How did you restore your relationship?

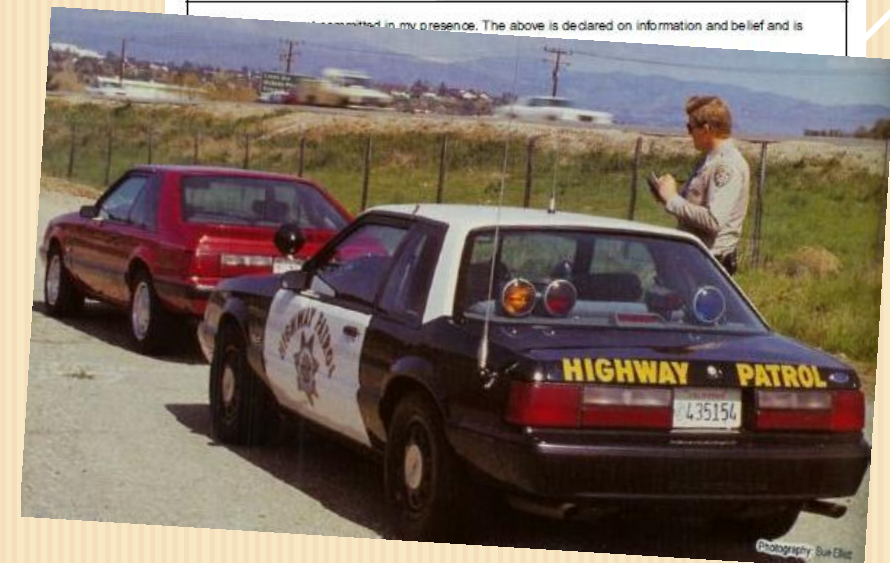

- (B) Jesus died and rose again

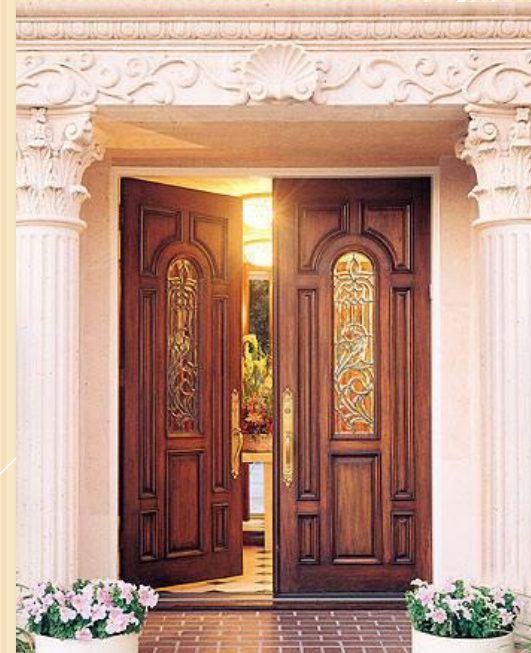

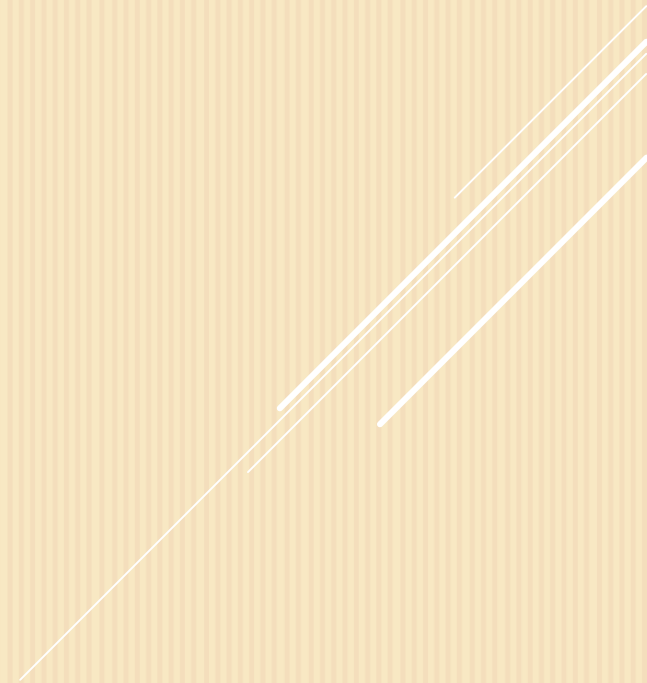
Praying
